## Program Information

The Certificate of Graduate Study (COGS) in Cybersecurity Architecture is designed to offer students the opportunity of a specialized study to provide students with experience in key courses of this discipline at the graduate level.

Students seeking this COGS will be required to take 1 required course and 3 restricted electives. This COGS is “stackable.” That is, all of the courses count for the MS in Computer Science and some count for the MS in Cybersecurity. All courses are 3 semester hours.
