

ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Each team will present on an assigned movie/video/topic. All members of the team must help in preparing slides for the presentation. Team leaders will delegate specific slides to their members.

- **Each team is responsible for selecting speakers for the presentation.**
- **The presentation duration for each team is 10 minutes with 5 minutes for questions. Typically a ten minute oral presentation will require 12-15 slides excluding title slide.**

Your presentation must include the following:

- Title slide with team member names
- Setting of the event; Brief information about the country/state/city etc; Include both social, economical and environmental information
- Contaminant characteristics: Chemistry and health impacts
- Conclusion: What is the moral/ethical/social value of the assigned video/movie/event? Did it impact legislation/environmental regulations etc.
- Please address social, gender, racial biases/discrimination issues.

Tips for presentation evaluation

Presentation Component	Ask yourself...	Grade (points max, each)
Oral Communication	Did they clearly explain their objectives? Could you hear them? Did they speak at a good rate?	15
Visual Communication	Did the visuals help you to better understand the design? Were words and equations legible?	15
Professionalism	Did they present in a professional manner? How did they respond to questions?	15
Technical Content	Does the team have an adequate knowledge of their assigned research topic?	15
Team Dynamics	Did the team portray that they respected each other and allowed all to have a voice in the presentation?	15
Overall	Was the presentation well organized? Did they introduce and summarize?	25
